





#### From the Prez

I trust you are surviving the winter months – won't be long until we are complaining about the nor' westers (well, that's my positive spin anyway). As always, it's a very busy time here at Elmwood, with plenty in the planning stages for an exciting 2015-16 year.

#### **Theatre Workshops**

We held a very successful two day workshop for directors and actors last month. Facilitated by recognised, professional tutors (Dan Pengelly and Bryan Aitken), I have no doubt that those who attended benefited greatly. We have one final workshop planned for the year, for aspiring playwrights, and this is scheduled for September. More details to follow.

#### One Act Plays

We have three short NZ plays currently in rehearsal mode. They will be presented as a one week season in the Elmwood auditorium in August, under the banner "Some Like It Short". Bookings will open mid-July. All three plays will be entered in this year's Theatre NZ play festival, which is scheduled for Nasda studios on I and 2 August

This year sees the end of the 20 year Agreement between Elmwood Players and Elmwood Normal School. I'm pleased to advise that we are now in the finalising stages of extending our agreement for a further 15 year period.

#### "Proof"

#### **Musical Revue**




